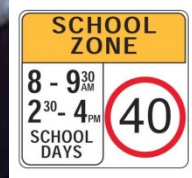

2019 Student Requirements



Bookpacks are available for all students to use in their classroom. The bookpacks include a selection of exercise books, stationery items and for Years 1 to 6 a Wellbeing Journal.

The cost of the pack for Kindergarten students is \$15 and for Years 1 to 6 \$25 (the cost reflects the inclusion of the Journal and payment will be required before students can access them). We will no longer request a School Contribution of \$35 per year.
